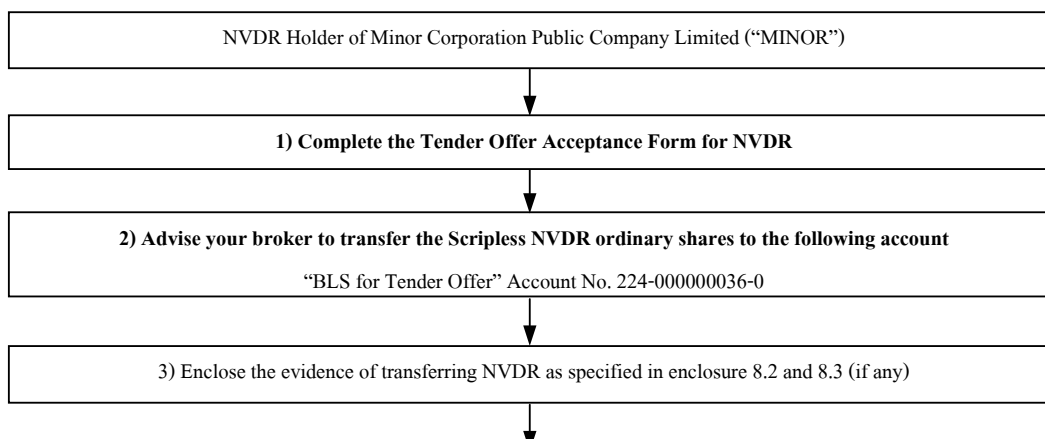


Tender Offer Acceptance Procedures for NVDR



4) Enclose the following supporting documents with certified as true copy, as the case may be:

4.1) Thai Individual

- A copy of ID Card or
- A copy of Civil Servant ID Card or A copy of State Enterprise Employee Card and A copy of House Registration

In case of name, title, or surname discrepancy between that appears on the security certificate and that appears on the identification card, the offeree has to fill in the "Request Form for Rectifying Items in the Security Holder Record" of the TSD, as in the Attachment 11, to be submitted with a copy of evidence of such name change issued by the government authority.

4.2) Foreign Individual

A copy of Passport or A copy of Alien Certificate

4.3) Thai Juristic Person

4.3.1 A copy of the Company Affidavit, issued by the Ministry of Commerce no longer than 1 year before the last day of the tender offer period, together with company seal (if any) and certified true copy by authorized director

4.3.2 Documents stated in No. 4.1) or 4.2) of the person(s) who is duly authorized by the company to certify true copy of document in 4.3.1 above

4.4) Foreign Juristic Person

4.4.1 A copy of certificate of incorporation and affidavit issued by the officer of the juristic person or the government authority of the country in which the juristic person is located, certifying the name of the juristic person, the authorized directors, the location of the head office and power or conditions of signing authorization (issued no longer than 1 year before the last day of the tender offer period, certified as true copy by the authorized directors of the juristic person)

4.4.2 Documents stated in No. 4.1) or 4.2) of the person(s) who is duly authorized by the company to certify true copy of document in 4.4.1 above

Document in 4.4.1 and 4.4.2 must be certified by the notary public officer and Thai embassy or Thai consulate in the country where the documents are prepared and all documents, which are issued, must not be longer than 1 year before the last day of the tender offer period

In case of a foreign juristic person not carrying on business in Thailand and residing in a country that has no double tax treaty with Thailand or residing in a country that has double tax treaty with Thailand, but such treaty does not exempt the Foreign Juristic Person from withholding tax on the capital gains realized from the sale of securities in Thailand, the Offeree has to declare cost basis of shares by submitting the Confirmation of Securities Cost Form attached with the evidence of such cost for the purpose of collecting applicable withholding tax. If the said form is not submitted or proper evidence of the cost basis is not included with the form, the tender offer agent will collect withholding tax in the amount calculated based on the market value of offered MINT shares **or NVDR ordinary shares to be received by the Offeree** (the closed price of MINT shares multiplies by the number of allotted MINT shares). **In case, there is capital gain realized from the tender of MINOR's securities, the Offeree must attach a cheque or evidence of a transfer slip for the payment of applicable withholding tax on such capital gain as stated in the Confirmation of Securities Cost Form.**

In case of security holder's authorized representative

1. Power of Attorney affixed with Baht 10 of the stamp duty; and
2. Certified true copy of identification documents of the authorized person and security holder as specified above
